1. The portfolio consideration

The consideration for the portfolio of the main educational program of higher education – programs for the training of scientific and scientific-pedagogical personnel at the Graduate School of Law programme "Law" in scientific specialties 5.1.1 Theoretical and Historical Legal Sciences, 5.1.2 Public Law (State Law) Sciences, 5.1.3 Private Law (Civilistic) Sciences, 5.1.4 Criminal Law Sciences, 5.1.5 International Legal Sciences consists of reviewing documents confirming the results of the applicant's scientific, academic and/or professional activities.

2. Portfolio structure

To participate in the individual achievement competition (portfolio) The applicant can provide the following documents in Russian or English:

1. The applicant's CV as a basis for determining their research potential, along with their publications and interviews, should include the following information:

- Full name
- Date and place of birth
- Contact information (phone number and email address)
- Information about additional educational experiences (additional education, advanced training, etc.)
- List of scientific publications (if available)
- Participation in Russian and international scientific conferences (if available)
- Research projects (if available)
- Summer/winter schools (if available)
- Grants, student research competition wins, or young scientist research competitions (if applicable)
- Work experience (if available)
- Information about knowledge of foreign languages, including the level of proficiency and any relevant certificates (if available).
- Information about the planned research topic, its scientific significance, and the HSE project in which the applicant is expected to participate if accepted.

Within the CV, the applicant may indicate one of the HSE projects listed on the Graduate School of Law's website or other HSE platforms.

2. **Publications on law (if any)**, listed with full publication details. The texts of the publications are provided as scanned PDF copies. Information from the publishers regarding the review of the publication, its acceptance for publication, etc., is not considered.

3. Components included in the portfolio documents

The selection procedures for applicants to the quota places are held in the portfolio consideration format

The portfolio is not evaluated according to criteria and scores.

CV
The ability for academic work needs to be fully demonstrated; sufficient experience in participating in scientific projects and events has been gained; the planned topic corresponds to the declared scientific specialty and the one open at the HSE Research Institute

Scientific publications on law
availability of a published article in a refereed journal indexed in the Lists A-D of the Higher School of Economics, written individually (check https://scientometrics.hse.ru/en/lists/)
availability of articles in scientific journals included in the List of the Higher Attestation Commission, written individually
availability of publications that include only abstracts of reports, chapters in conference proceedings, preprints, articles in scientific journals that are not included in the Lists, carried out individually
